## **ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

Applications for absentee ballots are available at the office of the Town Clerk, 14755 Route 22, New Lebanon. Completed applications must be received in the office of the Town Clerk at least seven (7) days before the Special Election, if the ballot is to be mailed to the qualified elector or voter, or on the day before the Special Election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the qualified elector or voter or his or her agent. Absentee ballots must be received by the Town Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. of the day of the election.
